


#### Scope of Research in Big Data Analytics


#### New Ventures for Budding Entrepreneurs






#### POWER OF INSTAGRAM MARKETING FOR STARTUP




## Department of Computer Science Academic Year 2020-2021 Boot Camp for Start-Up on Web Development

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




#### **Innovations in Plant Drug Development**
