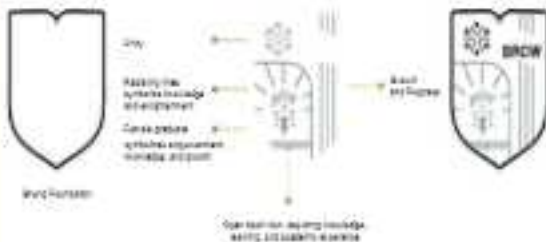

PROFILE OF THE INSTITUTION

Sri Ramakrishna College of Arts and Science for Women enjoys the reputation of being a most preferred women's institution for higher learning in the city since its establishment in 1951. With an academic heritage of over 34 years of existence as a self-financing institution, the college excels in fulfilling the holistic educational needs required for the empowerment of women.

The college is affiliated to Bharathiar University and is reaccredited by **NAAC with 'A+' Grade**. The institution has been conferred with Autonomous Status by the University Grants Commission (UGC) from the academic year 2016-25. The institution is ranked in the 151 - 200 band in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), the annual ranking exercise of higher education institutions by Ministry of Education, Government of India. The college has been approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for BCA and BBA Programmes from the academic year 2019-25. The college is also certified by ISO 9001:2015. With 34 UG Programmes, 5 PG programmes and 6 Ph.D. Programmes, the institution has produced 13000 graduates in UG and PG since inception.

The institution has signed MoUs with international universities such as James Cook University and Academies Australasia in Singapore and Asia Pacific University of Technology and Innovation and Quest International University in Malaysia for collaborations in research and academic activities. 10. Faculty members are allotted for every student in addition to Class Advisor. Students or parents may contact them for any help.
11. Parents can Monitor the progress of their wards through Google Apps.

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Anti-Ragging Rules

Ragging is a criminal offence and as a measure of prevention the Anti-Ragging Committee of the Institution has formulated the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level, shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- (i) Cancellation of admission
- (ii) Suspension from attending classes
- (iii) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- (iv) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- (v) Withholding results
- (vi) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- (vii) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- (viii) Expulsion from the institution for period ranging from 3 to 6 semesters
- (ix) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution
- (x) Fine of Rs.upto 25,000/-
- (xi) Collective punishment when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure continuously pressure on the potential raggers.

Attendance

1. Students should be seated before the faculty enters the class.
2. Absence for one or more hours during a session will be treated as absence of half a day.
3. Students should put in a minimum of 75% attendance in every semester and will not be allowed to appear for university examinations if the attendance falls short of the university requirements.
4. Medical leave applications will be entertained only if the duration of leave exceeds five consecutive days. Medical certificate should be submitted within three days after resuming class.

Identity Cards

- Students should wear the identity card duly signed by the Principal at all time during the college hours and identifying the examination.

Library Rules

9. Renewal is allowed if the concerned books are not returned by others.
10. Books borrowed from the library are not to be sold.
11. A fee of Rs.1 will be collected as Overdue charge, if the books are not returned on the due day.
12. Loss of books issued, if any, should be reported to the library immediately.
13. Members must sign on the book, if not with their own name with number charge. If the borrower is unable to replace the lost book, triple the cost of the book will be collected.

1. Annual examination will be conducted for the benefit of the students. They should attend all the internal examinations.

Hostel Rules

- Hostels must abide by the rules and regulations of the hostel.
- Discipline has to be maintained in the hostel premises.
- Students should keep their rooms and hostel premises clean.
- Each student has to be maintained in a good way (max 10 days per 100 per).
- In addition to the rules and regulations, students should appear in person for the hostel (25 per).
- Hostels are responsible for the safety keeping of their personal belongings.
- Greater damage to the hostel property will be the collective responsibility of all the hostel students.
- Guests should not be allowed to enter the hostel premises.
- Students should have their food in the dining hall only and are not allowed to take food items anywhere outside the dining hall or to the rooms.
- College bus will be provided for pickup and drop in and from the college and they are allowed not to come by road. Students should report to the bus at 8:00 am.
- Hostels are permitted to go home during 1st and 4th week ends after applying through email and getting approval from parents and seniors.
- During vacation period in case of personal sick leave, the students should submit the permission leave letter duly signed by the dean/chair and the head of the department to the hostel warden and get approval from WMS.
- The student must leave the hostel room after obtaining permission from the hostel warden.
- In case of absence during working days, the students should submit their leave application duly signed by the warden to the concerned department.
- In case of absence from the college after college hours, the permission duly signed by the staff is required to be submitted to the warden.
- The student should produce permission letter from the parent duly signed by, concerned Dean/Chair/Chairman to the warden and Head of the department stating the duration of absence and to ensure good permission for attending training program at outside the college.
- Hostels should not allow or permit students to enter the hostel without permission.
- Students are required to eat their meals only during working hours. Working days: 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. Holidays: 8:00 am to 6:00 pm.
- Regulation is strictly prohibited for smoking.
- Any student found guilty of misconduct, disruptive behavior etc. will be subjected to disciplinary action.
- Students will be provided with 2 visitors card for visitors and 4 visitors only after verifying the WhatsApp Card the Students will be permitted to leave the hostel.
- Approval letter from the parents is a must for self-going students.
- When vacating the hostel, parents are not allowed to pick up the students from the hostel. Guardians are not allowed to pick up students from the hostel with weapons, including children and family members.

FEE PAYMENT

1. Semester fees, Examination Fees and Hostel Fees for each semester should be paid on or before the last date. Semester fees and Hostel fees should be paid through Siksha Application.
2. The names of those who do not pay the tuition fees on or before the last date will be removed from the rolls.
3. Principal may consider resession of such students at per her discretion.
