29.01.2020


The students underwent a preliminary test about the chromatographic techniques and discussed about the career opportunities for this course. There was a Technical session about the three chromatographic techniques namely paper, thin layer and ion exchange chromatography. In this session the movement of compounds through the paper and thin layer chromatography was discussed in depth. The formation of bands was seen through the UV Trans illuminator.




The second day of the session started with the analysis of compounds through ion exchange chromatography, the separation of bovine serum albumin and confirmation test was conducted to determine the presence of antibody. Affinity and column chromatographic technique was taught. The gel was prepared by the students for both the techniques.

31.01.2020

In the third day of the training, the analysis of the antibodies and antigen were analysed by the students. The formation of precipitant arc was observed in the slide. The students were able to predict the inference of the experiment. And the separation of plant sample was also observed through column chromatography and multiple bands were observed. And the second half of the session, the students were divided into 10 groups and the separation kits were given and self experiment and analysis was done by students followed by a presentation about all the chromatographic separation techniques. The session ended with post assessment test for the students.
