

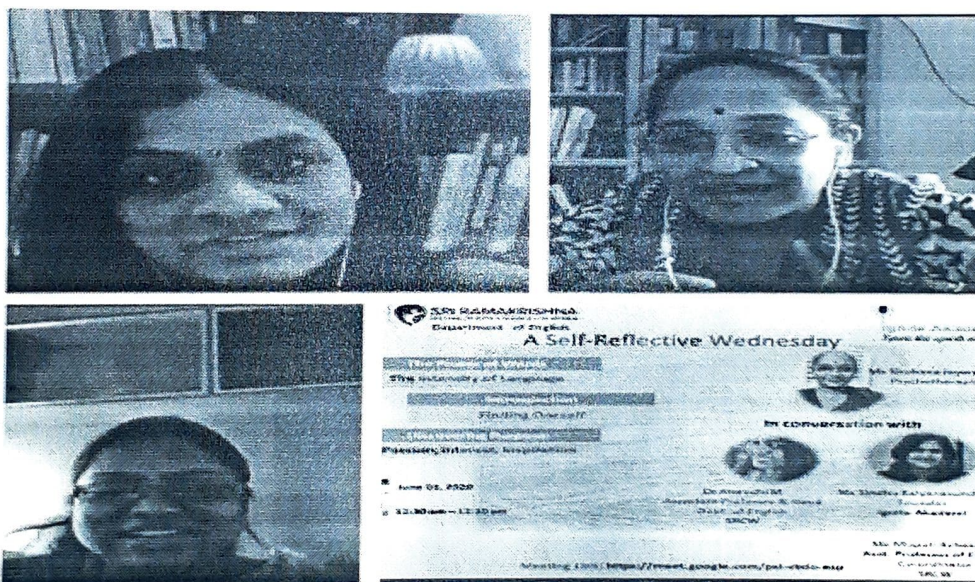

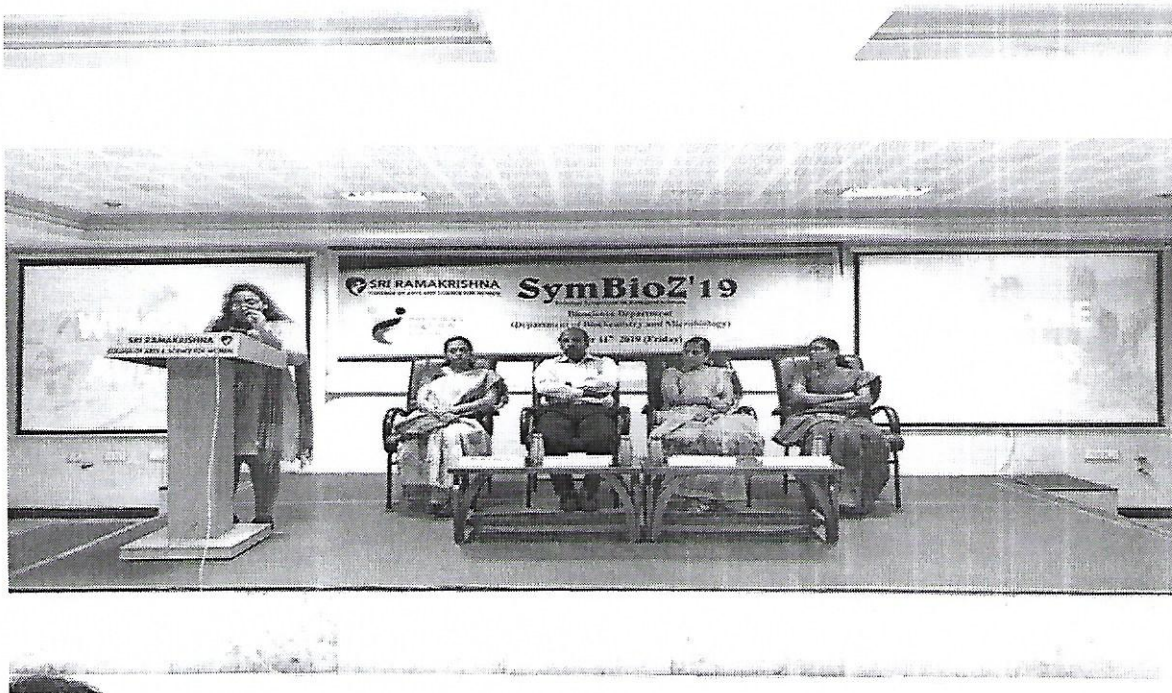


## Technical Symposium on Biological Sciences

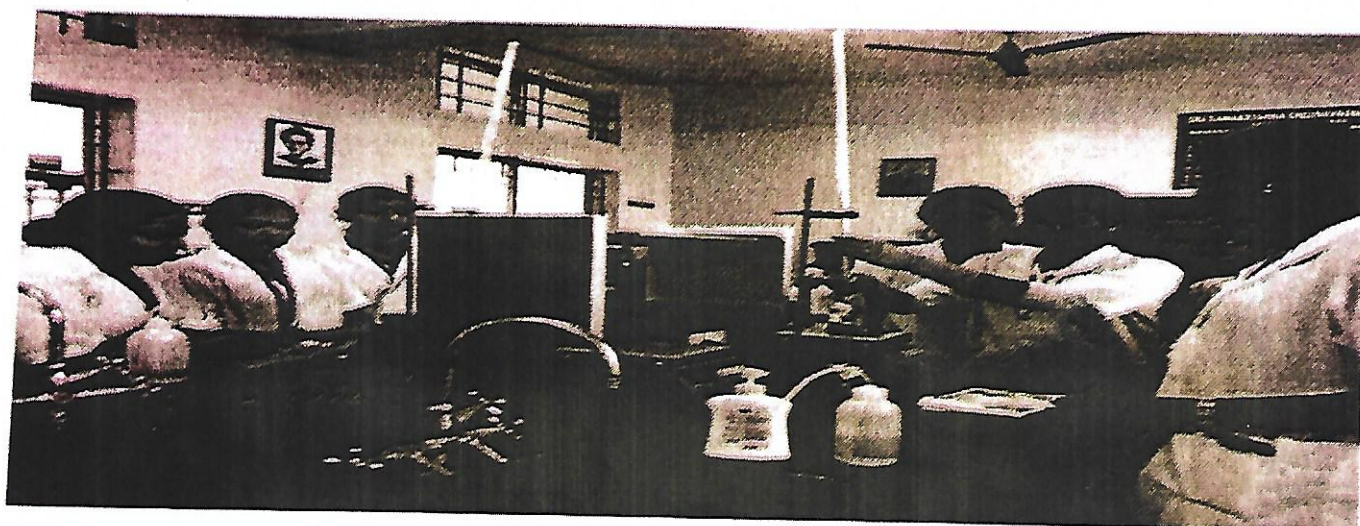

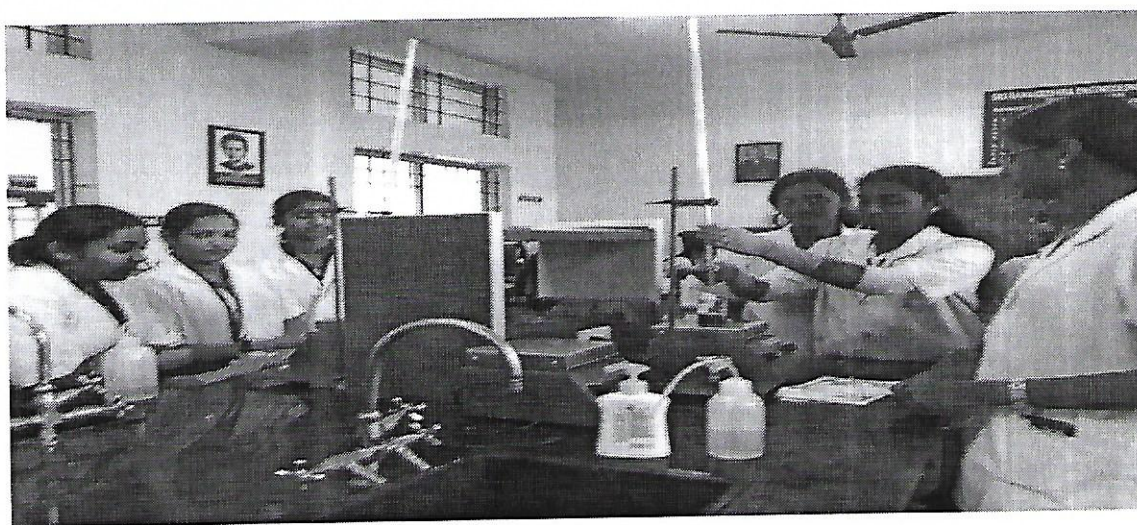


