IQAC Coordinator Dr.N.Tajunisha presented the report of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the academic year 2019-2020 and the plan of action for the year 2020 - 2021 as per NAAC Criteria.

- iii. Conducted Online Concept level to assess the learning levels of the students.
- iv. As a part of innovation cell activity, 32 teams submitted proposals to Smart India Hackathon 2020. One team from Micro selected for final.
- v. One team from Computer Science Won Cash prize in a Hackathon organized by Sree Saraswathi Thyagaraja College, Pollachi.
- vi. Innovation cell organized Idea Competitions.
- vii. Signed MoU with APU University, CyberJaya University, Malaysia.
- viii. R. Pranitharaj won Gold, Silver, and Bronze at National level Silambam championship, Coimbatore.
- ix. S.Monisha Received State level Award for Sports Swimming, 100M Back Stroke and 50M Butterfly.
- x. Received green audit certification from TUV Rheinland.

Suggestions given by Dr.N.Rajeswari

- Specific details regarding the bridge courses, contents etc. may be presented along with the students details regarding for whom it is conducted and the improvement after the bridge course.
- It was recommended to strengthen the IPR related activities and mention the outcome of all such workshop/activities conducted earlier.
- Suggested to collect audio/video/written feedback regarding mentoring from the students.
- Suggested to analyze the outcome of the certificate courses/Value added courses and link to placement/ other activities viz., entrepreneurship etc. through a summary report for the NAAC peer team visit. Statistical data must be presented related to outcome wherever possible.
- Suggested to frame Faculty Development Cell as carrying out all the FDPs along with other quality initiatives will be difficult for IQAC.
- Advised to include Student Induction program under the Capability Enhancement Program.
- Regarding the remedial classes, it was suggested to do input/output analysis and link the results to outcome.
- In general , it was advised to link all activities and reports to outcome as it is expected by NAAC.

Suggestions given by Dr.Krishnaveni

- Number of MOOC courses completed by students/faculty can be given in presentations as it may carry weightage for NAAC
- Suggested to organize Innovation workshop through IIC.
- Suggested to organize patent proposal and Technology commercialization workshop.
- Outcome of the Unnat Bharat Abiyan activities viz., the number of families benefitted, number of women trained etc. should be included.
